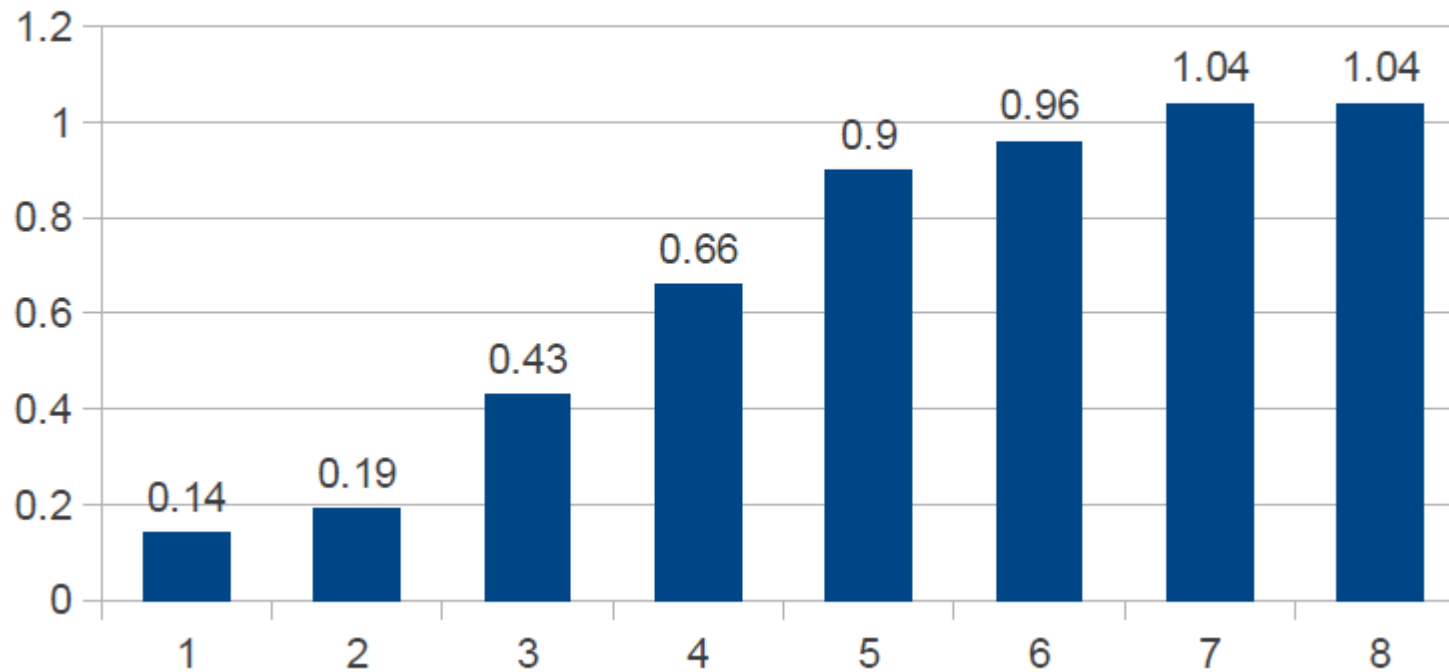


Principles for this year
