INTRODUCTION

AT THE KIND INVITATION OF TURKISH STATE METEOROLOGICAL SERVICE (TSMS), REGULAR $24^{\rm TH}$ ALADIN GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND $5^{\rm TH}$ JOINT ALADIN GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND HIRLAM COUNCIL WILL BE HELD AT THE HILTON ISTANBUL BOSPHORUS, ISTANBUL, TURKEY, BETWEEN 16 AND 17 DECEMBER 2019. THE OPENING SESSION OF THE MEETING WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE HOTEL IN THE NOON ON MONDAY 16 DECEMBER 2019.

1. Transfers from Airports

a. Istanbul International Airport (IATA: IST; ICAO: LTFM)




Figure 1. Transfer from Istanbul Airport to Hilton Istanbul Bosphorus Hotel by taxi or private car.




Figure 2. Transfer from Istanbul Airport to Hilton Istanbul Bosphorus Hotel by public transportation.

Located on the European side of Istanbul, by the Black Sea shore, Istanbul International Airport is 45 kilometers to Hotel and, it takes approximately 45 to 75 minutes (depending on traffic) by taxi and private car (Figure 1); and 1hour and 20 minutes to 2 hours and 30 minutes by public transportation (Figure 2).

Participants who want to take a **taxi** to arrive in the hotel will pay approximately **30** € (depending on the car class, taxis have different color and fare; yellow and red taxicabs apply lower rate and, blue and black colored ones are higher rates). Recommended public transfer option is taking **IST-19** bus, also called **Havaist**, operating every 15 minutes between 05:10 am to 08:00 pm, every 20 minutes between 08:00 pm and 01:00 am and every 30 minutes between 01:00 am and 04:30 am. It costs **18 TRY** and tickets could be bought on the bus with credit cards. Details can be reached via the official web page **https://hava.ist/en/new-timetables**, wherein the destination options Istanbul Airport is written in Turkish, "Istanbul Havalimani". Participants taking this bus will get off at the last station called Taksim, from here, Hotel is in 700 meters walking distance.

b. Sahiba Gökçen International Airport (IATA: SAW; ICAO: LTFJ)




Figure 3. Transfer from Sabiha Gokcen International Airport to Hilton Istanbul Bosphorus Hotel by taxi or private car.




Figure 4. Transfer from Sabiha Gokcen International Airport to Hilton Istanbul Bosphorus Hotel by public transportation.

Sabiha Gökçen International Airport is located on the Anatolian side of Istanbul in Pendik/Kurtköy. It is located 55 kilometers from Meeting Venue (Hilton Bosphorus). It takes approximately 45 to 90 minutes (Depending on traffic) by taxi and private car (Figure 3); and 1 hour and 30 minutes to 2 hours and 30 minutes (Figure 4) by public transportation.

Participants who want to take a taxi to arrive in the hotel will pay approximately 40 € (depending on the car class, taxis have different color and fare; yellow and red taxicabs apply lower rate and, blue and black colored ones are higher rates). The recommended public transfer option is taking the SG-2 bus, also called Havatas/Havabus, operating every 30 minutes between 04:00 am to 01:00 am. It costs 18 TRY and tickets could be bought on the bus with cash. Details can be accessed via the official web http://www.havabus.com/yolcuservisi/taksim-sabihagokcenhavalimani.aspx. Participants taking this bus will get off at the last station called Taksim, from here, Hotel is in 700 meters walking distance.

2. Accommodation

The price for single rooms per night based on half-board (including breakfast and lunch) is $120 \in$ and, $170 \in$ for double rooms. All reservations and any additional requests need to be addressed through Representative of the Local Organizing Committee.

Hilton Istanbul Bosphorus

Hilton Istanbul Bosphorus is located on the European side of the city; very close to Taksim Square, with its shops, restaurants, nightspots, and cafes (Figure 5).

Citizens of a number of countries need to have a visa before arriving in Turkey. Most visitors with confirmed round-tickets can obtain their entry visas at the airports, although this does not apply to certain nationalities. In those countries that do not have a Turkish embassy or consulate, participants may submit their application to a Turkish embassy or consulate in another country which covers the participant's country of origin. Participants are advised to contact an embassy or consulate as early as possible to obtain precise information on regulations and deadlines for submission of applications. 8. Electricity

In Turkey the power plugs and sockets are of type F. The standard voltage is 220 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz. An adaptor may be necessary.
